

Chataqua Parade 2011

Everyone loves a parade. This is an invitation to join us on Saturday, July 9th, 2011. We welcome all organizations, businesses, and clubs to activate your creative talents and march in the Chataqua parade. All entrants will be assigned a placement and issued a judging number at the registration table before line-up. The registration table is located on the corner of Webster and 2nd E. and is open at 7:30 am. There will be no prejudging.

Our parade announcer will announce the names and community events for those entries that are pre-registered. With your registration please submit a brief summary of your entry. Include the size of your entry for use in laying out the line-up. Late entries will be taken but due to the short notice of registration we can only guarantee that your name will be announced.

Young children must be accompanied by an adult while participating in the parade. ANY motorized entry (cars, 3-wheelers, scooters, tractors, etc.) must be driven by a person 16 years old or older with a valid driver's license. This will be enforced and any violation will result in the entire group leaving the parade. Exhibition of speed or any inappropriate driving will not be tolerated. Violators will be asked to leave the parade route.

Self powered floats must have a provision for towing in case of a breakdown and must comply with standard fire and mechanical safety codes. At least one operable fire extinguisher must be carried on all float entries. Each float entry must have insurance and provide the Chataqua parade director with a certificate of insurance.

All royalty will be required to provide their own transportation. After the parade a luncheon is provided for all visiting royalty. Horse units **MUST** provide someone to pickup after any accidents during the parade. Political candidates are required to pay \$50 advertising fee. Please make checks payable to Community Celebrations.

There will be **NO** throwing or tossing of any kind, including candy to the crowd. Anyone found throwing or tossing will be subject to a fine and will be asked to leave the route. If you wish to give anything to the crowd, you may personally hand the item to them.

Because of insurance requirements all parade entrants are required to sign a release and waiver of liability and indemnity agreement. Please return it with your entry.

1. Applicants age 18 and over, complete Part "A" only.
2. Applicants under age 18 must have parent or guardian complete Parts "A" & "B".

PART "A" - WAIVER & RELEASE FROM LIABILITY

In consideration of being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA (herein defined as the areas to which admission by general public spectators is prohibited), or being permitted to compete, officiate, observe, work for, or for any purpose participate in any way in the event, EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED, for himself, his personal representatives, heirs, next of kin, acknowledges, agrees and represents that he has, or will immediately upon entering any of such restricted areas, and will continuously thereafter, inspect such restricted area or areas and all portions thereof which he enters and with which he comes in contact, and he does further warrant that his entry upon such restricted area and that his participation, if any, in the event constitutes an acknowledgment that has inspected such restricted area and that he finds and accepts the same as being safe and reasonably suited for the purposes of his use, and he further agrees and warrants that if, at any time, he is in or about restricted areas and he feels anything to be unsafe, he will immediately advise the officials of such and will leave the restricted area(s):

1. HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE the Chewelah Chataqua, Community Celebrations, the promoters, other participants, operators, officials, any persons in a restricted area, sponsors, advertisers, owners and leasees of premises used to conduct the event and each of them, their officers and employees, all for the purposes herein referred to as "releasees," from all liability to the undersigned, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for any and all damage, and any claim or demands therefor on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise while the undersigned is in or upon the restricted area, and/or competing, officiating in, observing, or working for, or for any purposes participating in the event;

2. HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the releasees and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur due to the presence of the undersigned in or upon the restricted area or in any way competing, officiating, observing, or working for, or for any purpose participating in the event and whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.

3. HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to the negligence of releasees or otherwise while in or upon the restricted area and/or while competing, officiating, observing, or working for or for any purpose participating in the event.

4. EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED expressly acknowledges and agrees that the activities at the event and in the restricted areas are dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED further expressly agrees that the foregoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the Province or State in which the event is conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

THE UNDERSIGNED HAS READ AND VOLUNTARILY SIGNS THE RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, and further agrees that no oral representations, statements or inducement apart from the foregoing written agreement have been made.

This waiver, release and indemnification agreement specifically embraces each and every sanctioned, authorized or promoted by said releasees during the entire season and applies to each and every event, or activity hereinabove mentioned, and has the same effect as if executed after each and every activity or event in which the undersigned participates so that the parties herein intended to be released and indemnified shall be fully and effectively released and indemnified as to each and every event hereinabove described.
